

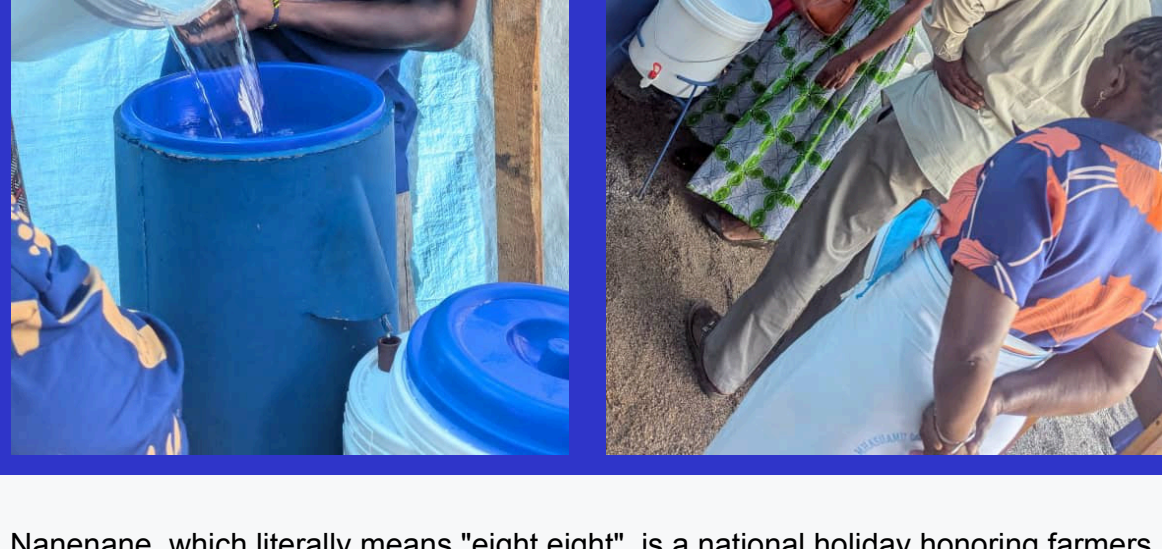


"Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever"

Hebrews 13:8

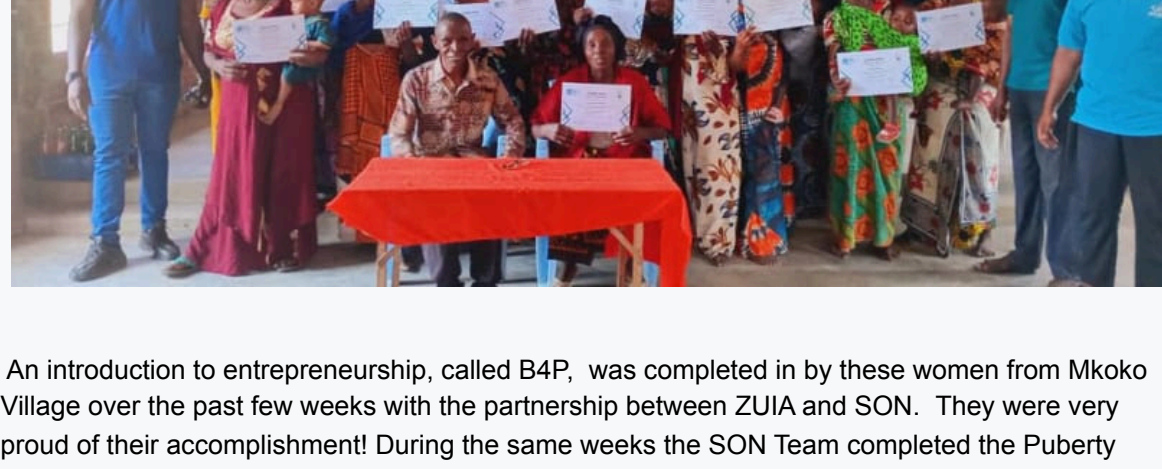

NaneNane festival in Morogoro Town

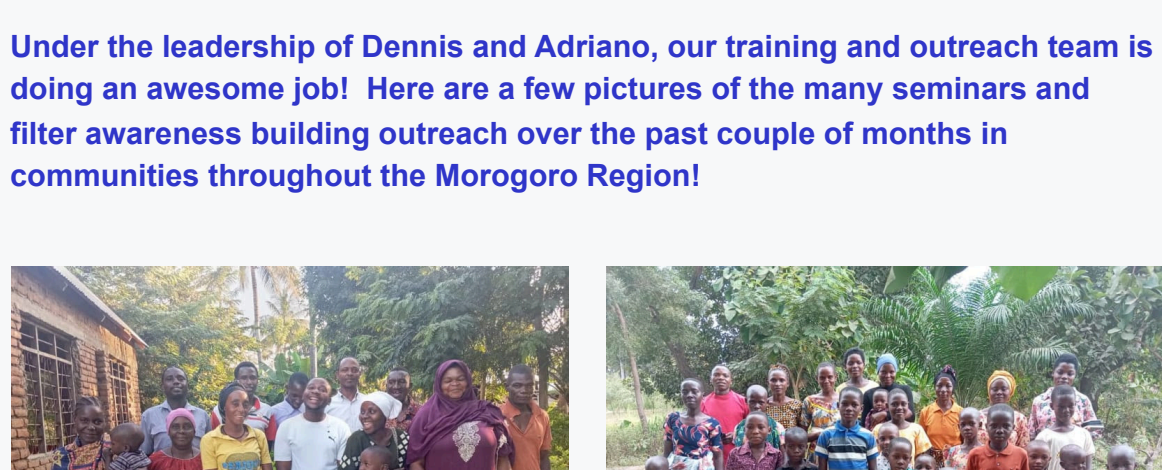
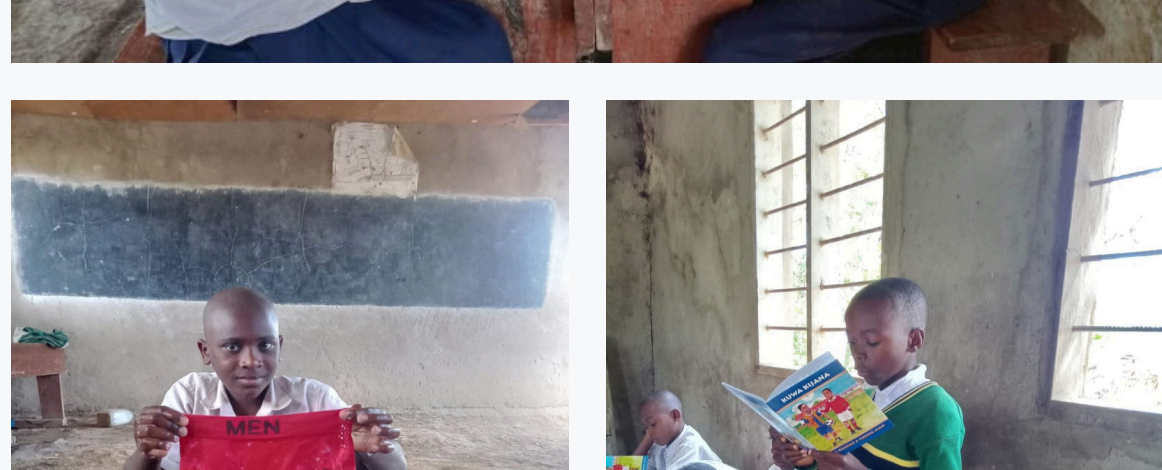

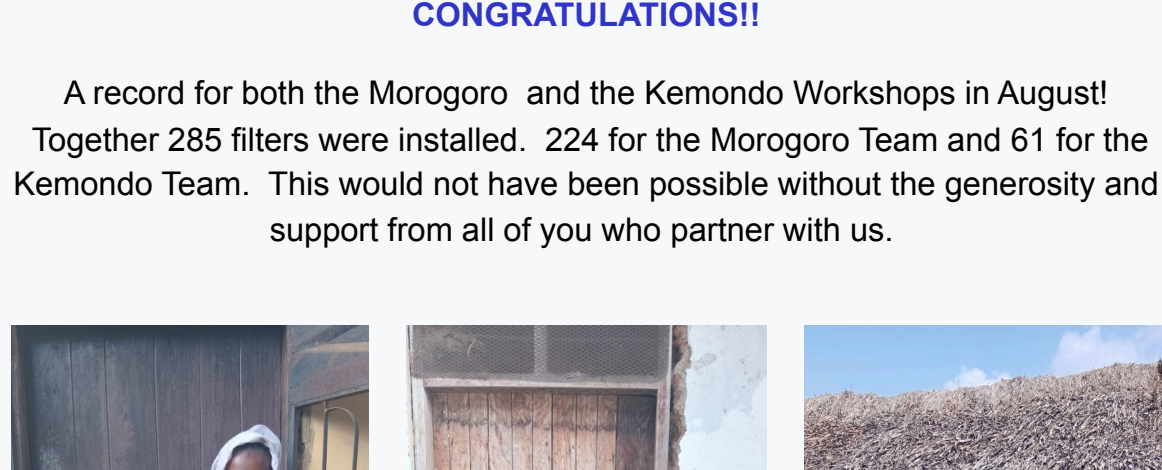
MKOKO VILLAGE

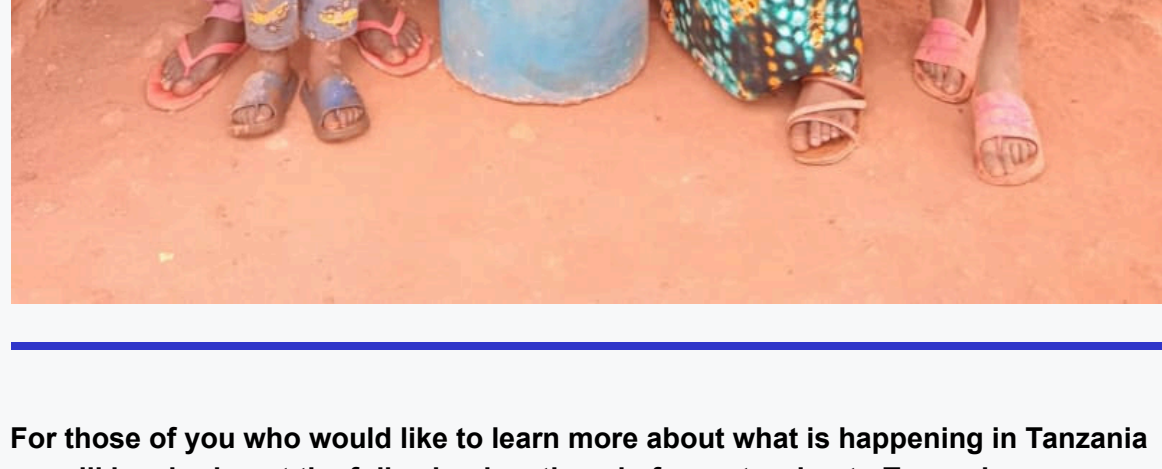
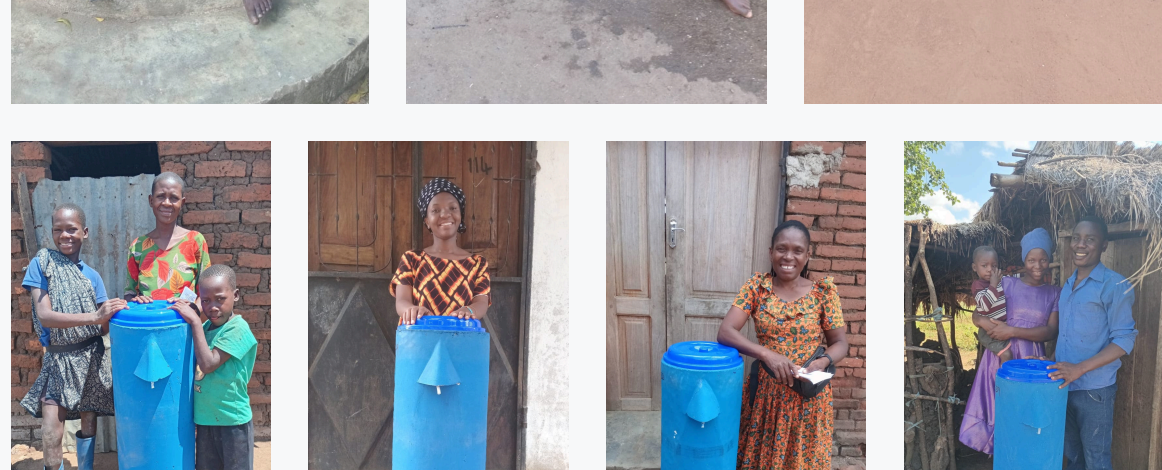
